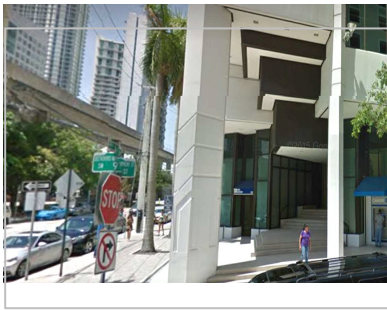




The Miami-Dade Beacon Council's offices are on the 24th floor (Suite 2400) of Brickell City Tower (aka, the Chase Bank Building). Directions vary if you are driving and parking in our garage vs. using Uber or public transportation, so please reference the appropriate address below when using your GPS or Uber/Lyft.

Pedestrian Access: For Ride Share/Drop Off or Walking Directions



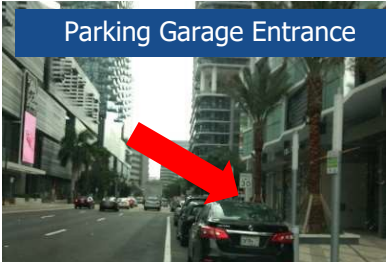
Map to this Address: 829 SW 1st Avenue, Miami, FL 33130

Metrorail Stop: Brickell Station (1001 SW 1st Avenue; across the street)

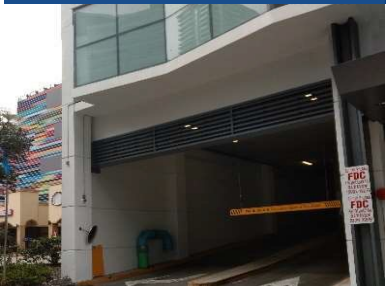
The only pedestrian access to our offices is on the south side of our building, on the corner of SW 9th Street and SW 1st Avenue. The main entrance is directly across the street from the entrance to Publix. You will see a Chase ATM on the right of the stairs – take the stairs to the lobby and the elevators on your right to the 24th floor.

Take SW 8th Street until you pass the light at SW 1st Avenue (you will see the Metrorail overhead). Ensure that you are in the right lane, as you will be turning right into the parking garage entrance on the right (see photos). The entrance to the garage is on 8th Street, directly across the street from the main entrance to Saks Fifth Avenue at Brickell City Center. The exact address for the entrance to the garage is 86 SW 8th Street, but there is NO SIGNAGE so you must be vigilant.

Once you enter the parking garage turn into the entrance on the left and take a ticket. You can park at any non-reserved parking space. Take parking garage elevator down to the lobby. Then take one of the 4 building elevators directly across from you to the 24th Floor.

Note: If you pass the entrance to the parking garage, you will need to quickly get over to the left lane to turn LEFT at Miami Avenue (between the 2 main Brickell City Center buildings) and go around the block, as it is all one-way streets. This is by far the quickest route by 10 minutes.
