A national cultural leader and an experienced grantmaker for the arts, he is the former Program Director for the Arts at the Doris Duke Charitable Foundation, which received the National Medal for the Arts from President Barack Obama. Prior to that, Cameron served as the Executive Director of Theatre Communications Group (TCG), the national service organization for nonprofit theaters and directed the theater program at the National Endowment for the Arts.
