

"The Underwater," Xavier Cortada's award-winning socially engaged art project, sparks widespread conversation and action around sea level rise. It is being implemented by the Cortada Foundation and is the subject of a TED Talk by the artist and the following art awards Creative Capital 2022 Awardee, Oolite Ellies 2023 Creator Award, and Miami-Dade Cultural Affairs Department Arts Resilient 305 Prize art awards. Major supporters include the Knight Foundation and the University of Miami Laboratory for Integrated Knowledge (U-LINK)'s On the Move: Climate Migration and Retreat in South Florida, the Caribbean, and Beyond interdisciplinary research team (where he serves as one of four principal investigators).
